Joachim Winter (joint with Christian Traxler (NA))	Survey Evidence on Conditional Norm Enforcement, University of Munich, Discussion Papers, <i>Abstract</i> : We discuss survey evidence on individuals' willingness to sanction norm violations - such as evading taxes, drunk driving, fare dodging, or skiving off work - by expressing disapproval or social exclusion. Our data suggest that people condition their sanctioning behavior on their belief about the frequency of norm violations. The more commonly a norm violation is believed to occur, the lower the individuals' inclination to punish it.
